To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

- 1 piece of Whisper White thick cardstock measuring 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for card base
- 1 piece of Petal Pink cardstock measuring 4" x 5 ¼" to stamp inside sentiment on
- 1 piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock cut 4" x 5 1/4" for layering
- 1 Piece of Whisper White cardstock cut 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" to adhere Beautifully Detailed Laser Cut Specialty Paper cut at 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" or a pretty piece of vellum if you have one cut at 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5"
- 1- 3 ¾" x 5" piece of Adhesive Sheet (Do not use this if your laser paper has cut outs, use glue instead) Use adhesive sheet with vellum only!
- 1 piece of Mossy Meadow Cardstock cut to 4 %" x 4 %" to Stamp Magnolia image on with Mossy Meadow Ink
- 1 piece of Whisper White Thick Cardstock cut to 4 %" x 4 %" to stamp Magnolia image on with Mossy Meadow Ink
- 1 piece of Mossy Meadow rectangle cut 1" x 2 ¼" from a scrap piece of Mossy Meadow
- 1 Piece of Petal Pink rectangle cut ¾" x 2" to stamp "Thanks" on

Big Shot or other die cutting machine

Instructions

- Step 1. Cut all the pieces according to the measurements except the pieces that have to be cut with a die.
- Step 2. Next stamp the magnolia image on the 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock with the Mossy Meadow Ink Pad
- Step 3. Stamp the Whisper White thick cardstock measuring 4 %" x 4 %" with the same Magnolia Stamp using the Mossy Meadow Ink Pad.
- Step 4. Place the die that cuts out this image on one of the two pieces and run through your die cutting machine. Do the same with the other stamped piece of cardstock.
- Step 5. At this point take the white piece and color the center with So Saffron or something close to it. Then color some pink areas around the center of the piece with the Petal Pink. Next color the stem with the Early Expresso. Once you're finished with this, fussy cut the white magnolia image that you just colored away from the leaves.
- Step 6. Now you can glue the Magnolia image that you just colored to the solid Mossy Meadow one. Lay aside.
- Step 7. Stamp the "Thanks" onto a piece of Petal Pink cardstock measuring $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2" or you can stamp on a larger piece of cardstock and then cut the rectangle around the sentiment. Which ever you prefer is fine. Also cut a piece of Mossy Meadow into a 1" x 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle if you haven't already done so. Before you glue together use the $\frac{1}{4}$ " round punch to clip the corners on both pieces. After that glue the petal pink piece on top of the Mossy Meadow piece and lay aside.
- Step 8. Stamp the inside sentiment on the piece of Petal Pink cardstock and lay aside.

- Step 9. Now go back and glue the Beautifully Detailed Laser-Cut Specialty Paper in Petal Pink to the 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" piece of Whisper Cardstock. After that glue this piece to the piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock measuring 4 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Step 10. Take Stampin' Dimensionals and place on the back of the Magnolia cut out using the Take Your Pick tool. Remove the protective coverings and then adhere to the right side of the card which is positioned in a horizontal fashion.
- Step 11. Take the sentiment rectangle that has "Thanks" stamped on it and glue it to the left side of the Magnolia image.
- Step 12. Color the clear gems with the Petal Pink blends. When dry you can put a glue dot on the front of the card where you want the gems to be. It is not required to use a glue dot, but it does mean they will most likely stay put with a little extra adhesive.
- Step 13. Glue this piece to the front of the card in a horizontal position.
- Step 14. Then glue the inside sentiment into place on the inside of the card.
