- 2 piece of Blueberry Bushel cardstock measuring 4 x 5 1/4" for layering
- 2 pieces of cardstock Thick Whisper White measuring 3 ¾" x 5" for stamping
- 1 piece of thick Whisper White cardstock cut 1 3/8" x 5" for layering
- 1 piece of Blueberry Bushel Cardstock measuring 1 ½" x 5" fancy die piece from
- 1 piece of Blueberry Bushel Cardstock measuring 3" x 4" to cut label from

Heat Tool

Instructions

Step 1. Cut all the pieces according to the measurements except the pieces that have to be cut with a die.

- Step 2. Next stamp the inside sentiment onto one of the pieces of Whisper White Cardstock that was cut 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" using the Blueberry Bushel Ink. Take the other piece of Whisper White Cardstock measuring 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" and stamp the flower design all over it.
- Step 3. Take the piece of Blueberry Bushel measuring 3" x 4" and run the embossing buddy over it on the side you are going to stamp the sentiment. This removes oil or static. Stamp the sentiment in the center of this piece with Versa Mark Ink. Sprinkle the white embossing powder over the sentiment. Tap sides for good coverage or turn cardstock. Lastly tap the back of the cardstock to remove all excess powder. Do this over a clean piece of cardstock so that you can pour the excess back into the container and use again. Turn on your heat tool and give it a minute to heat up. Once it is hot hold the heat near the sentiment until it starts to melt. Move the heat tool over the sentiment until the white powder has melted. Do not hold in any one spot too long as it could scorch it.
- Step 4. Take the piece of Blueberry Bushel Cardstock measuring 1 ½" x 5" and lay long fancy die on it. The sharp side should always be next to the cardstock. Run through your die machine.
- Step 5. Take the piece of Blueberry Bushel Cardstock that you just embossed and lay the large label die on it centering your sentiment. Run through the die.
- Step 6. Now it is time to assembly the card. First glue the flowered piece measuring $3\frac{3}{4}$ " X 5" to a piece of the Blueberry Bushel measuring 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Next glue the fancy long piece cut from Blueberry Bushel to the piece of Whisper White measuring 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 5". Take this piece and glue to the flowered piece leaving a tiny boarder on the left side of the front of the card.
- Step 7. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the sentiment label. Adhere to the front of the card slightly above the center.
- Step 8. Glue the other Whisper White piece that is stamped with the inside sentiment to the last piece of Blueberry Bushel Cardstock. Lastly, glue this piece to the inside of the card leaving an even border of Whisper White.

This makes a lovely card for a friend!
