To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

- 1 piece of Whisper White cardstock measuring 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for card base
- 2 piece of Night of Navy cardstock measuring 4 x 5 1/4" for layering
- 2 pieces of cardstock Balmy Blue cardstock measuring 3 ¾" x 5" for stamping
- 1 piece of Gray Granite cardstock for stamping lighthouse about a 1/2 of a piece measuring 3 3 x 5"
- 1 scrap of Whisper White for stamping sail boat and sentiment on
- 1 narrow piece of Night of Navy cardstock to cut long narrow piece for inside of the card

Stamp Set & Die

Sailing Home Bundle (save 10% when stamps and dies are purchased as a unit) High Tide (optional)

Ink

Simple Shammy- This is great to clean stamps especially photopolymer

Instructions

- Step 1. Cut all the pieces according to the measurements except the pieces that have to be cut with a die.
- Step 2. Stamp the Lighthouse in the corner of the piece of Gray Granite cardstock with Real Red Ink Pad. Make sure you wipe off the bottom of the stamp where the grass is going to be before stamping. If you want rocks around the Lighthouse, use the Early Expresso Ink Pad and coat only the lower portion of the stamp with ink. Use the watercolor markers to accent the Lighthouse. Color around the base of the light house with the Old Olive Green Blend. Now use your scissors to fussy cut this out. Lay aside. Stamp the sailboat onto the piece of Whisper White Cardstock using the Night of Navy Ink pad. Color the bottom of the boat with a Real Red Watercolor marker. Take the Balmy Blue Blend and color in what would be water behind the sailboat. Next stamp the Congrats on a small piece of Whisper White cardstock using the Night of Navy Ink Pad. Next stamp the inside sentiment and the little sailboat in Night of Navy on one piece of the Balmy Blue Cardstock. On the other piece of Balmy Blue Cardstock stamp the water from the High Tide Stamp set or use the Night of Navy Watercolor marker to make ripples of water. Lastly stamp some birds in the air.
- Step 3. Place the proper die on the sailboat, and the Congrats and run through the die machine. You may want to use a little Post It tape to hold in place so you get a nice cut. Also, you will need to use the tiny narrow long die to cut a piece from the Night of Navy Cardstock.
- Step 4. Glue the lighthouse to the piece of Balmy Blue Cardstock with water stamped or drawn on it. Next put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the sailboat and the Congrats banner. Remove the protective coverings and place the banner over the lighthouse and the little sailboat in the water. Now glue this piece to one of the pieces of Night of Navy Cardstock and lastly glue this unit to the front of the card base.
- Step 5. Glue the very narrow braided looking strip to the left side of the inside sentiment piece. Trim the excess away. Now glue this piece to the last piece of Night of Navy layering piece. Lastly glue this unit to the inside of the card base.

This card makes a nice card for a young person pursuing a career for the first time.
