To Make This Card You Will Need The Following Items

Paper

½ sheet of an 8½" by 11" Basic White Cardstock cut to 8½" by 5½" (score at 4 ½")

1 piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ³/₄"" by 5"

1 piece of Basic White Cardstock cut 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (this is to stamp the ornaments on)

1 small piece of Basic White Cardstock to stamp sentiment on about 2 ½" x 2 ½'

2 pieces of Mossy Meadow Cardstock cut to 4" by 5 1/4"

1 piece of Be Dazzling specialty paper from the Sale-a-Bration Catalog measuring ½" x 3 ¾" and a piece big enough to cut scalloped circle from

1 piece of the Whimsy & Wonder Specialty(striped) paper cut to 3 3/4"" by 5"

1 piece of Whimsy & Wonder Specialty paper measuring 2 3/8" x 6" if you want to decorate back flap of envelope

Adhesive

Multipurpose Glue Stampin' Seal

Tools

Paper Trimmer Scissors Stamparatus Bone Folder Simple Shammy Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine

Stampin' UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making

Reverse tweezers with pointed tip Xyron adhesive eraser

Instructions

- 1. Cut your paper to specified sizes above.
- 2. Stamp sentiment onto Basic White cardstock measuring about 2 ½" x 2 ½'
- 3. Using the Stamparatus, stamp the images of the ornaments onto a piece of Basic White Cardstock measuring 4 ½" x 5 ½". Stamp across the 5 ½" side. Refer to my video to get a good picture how this can be done easily with the Stamparatus.
- 4. Stamp the inside sentiment on a piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 3/4" by 5"
- 5. Using the die cutting machine, cut out the front sentiment with the plain die that is just big enough to clear all the typing. Also cut the scalloped piece to match out of the Be Dazzling paper.
- 6. Using the Penned Flower Die set take the scalloped edge and cut a scalloped edge just below the ornaments. You may want to cut some of the excess cardstock away before you lay down your die. It just makes it easier to get straight. I'll will demonstrate in the video. Sometimes a picture is worth a thousand words.
- 7. Color the ornaments. I suggest using the lighter color of blends.
- 8. Cut the width of your ornament piece to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ ". Using tape runner glue the Be Dazzling specialty paper measuring $\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " to the top of the ornament piece.
- 9. Glue the sentiment piece onto the scalloped Be Dazzling piece. Cut straight across just under the last line of the sentiment.
- 10. Take the striped DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 3 ³/₄" x 5" and glue it to one of the pieces of Mossy Meadow Cardstock cut to 4" by 5 1/4".
- 11. Glue one snowflake in opposite corners of the striped piece.
- 12. Now center your ornament piece on the front of your card and glue to the front.
- 13. Glue the sentiment piece over the upper snowflake.
- 14. Now glue the inside sentiment piece to the last piece of Mossy Meadow card stock and adhere with glue to the inside of your card.

Envelope

Using your tape runner put tape on the top side of the flap of the envelope. Carefully lay your piece of DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6"on the flap starting at the fold of the flap. Trim and you are done!
