This is What You Will Need For The Painted Christmas Card

- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ³/₄" x 5" for the inside sentiment
- 1 Piece of Evening Evergreen Cardstock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (cut to 2 1/2" x 3 3/4" after embossing)
- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 2 ½" x 2 ½" for front sentiment
- 2 pieces of Real Red Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 1/4"
- 1 piece of Real Red about 3" x 3" to cut red border from (use die out of Christmas Season Bundle)
- 1 Piece of the Painted Christmas Paper cut to 2 ½" x 3 ¾"
- 1 piece of Basic White layering paper cut to 3 ³/₄" x 5"

Instructions

- 1. Cut all the paper from the list above.
- 2. Stamp The Wishing You a Merry Christmas on a piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 2 ½" x 2 ½".
- 3. Stamp Sending love & peace This Season on a piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ³/₄" x 5".
- 4. Place your piece of Evening Evergreen Cardstock 4 ¼" x 5 ½" into the Parisian Embossing Folder and spritz with a little water. Run through the die cutting machine and let dry. Cut this piece into two pieces measuring 2 ½" x 3 ¾" after embossing. Save one piece for another card.
- 5. Cut out the Wishing You A Merry Christmas using the scalloped circle that is just big enough to clear the print.
- 6. Using the piece of Real Red about 3" x 3" to cut red border use the die out of Christmas Season Bundle to cut the Real Red border piece.
- 7. Glue the piece of embossed Evening Evergreen and the piece of Painted Christmas Paper cut to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " onto the piece of Basic White layering paper cut to $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5". Trim any edges if you need to.
- 8. Cut 6" of Real Red Mini Ribbon and apply a little glue with Stampin Seal. Wrap around the front of the card where the two papers meet and secure on the back side.
 - 9. Now glue this panel to the front card base.
- 10. Glue the front sentiment to the Real Red border piece. Place dimensionals on back and adhere to the left side of card front placing 2/3 of the sentiment above the ribbon. Now tie a small bow and place to the right of the sentiment piece using glue dots.
- 11. Lastly glue the inside sentiment piece to the last piece of Real Red Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 1/4" and then to the right side of the inside card base.

Stampin' UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making
